Co-founder of CLQWN Mutiny, Company Member of 500 Clown, and cocreator of the Madam Barker Show, Brennan is a strong advocate for building one's own body of work in addition to working with established organizations.

In addition to her work with the 9-month intensive Pro Training program, she will be offering physical theater classes to the general population at The Actors Gymnasium starting in August.
