The fourth annual Backstage Evanston will showcase an exciting array of theater, dance and music companies from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. on Sept. 29, in the Ethel M. Barber Theater at Northwestern University. Doors will open at 2:30 p.m.

Presented by the Arts & Business Committee of the Evanston Arts Council and the City of Evanston, the event is one-stop-shopping for theater and music lovers. Fifteen groups will present five-minute performances and offer discounted tickets to their season's performances. These discounts will be offered only that day at Backstage Evanston.

This year, the special event will celebrate the 150th anniversary of Evanston by offering a historical glimpse of the participating groups via photographs and anecdotes.
